


## WILDWOOD LAKE ACCESS & FISHING RULES

1. Hours for lake use are Dawn to Dusk (no night fishing as we have residential neighbors and do not want to alarm them or scare them in thinking someone is lurking).
2. ID Pass: Your WARA-issued pass for the year (after paying dues) must be carried with you when using the lakes. Although we own the property within so many feet of the lakes, we allow our "neighbors" to build docks on our property. If they question why you are there, you can show your pass and tell them you have paid your dues to use our land and lakes. Please be kind and gracious to any property owner you encounter.
3. You are required to have a Virginia Fishing License through the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources and adhere to all DWR rules and regulations. For more information, visit their website at [dwr.virginia.gov](http://dwr.virginia.gov).
4. Small boats or kayaks can be launched from any of the lakes.
5. No gasoline-powered motors are allowed on the lake.
6. All trash must be removed when you leave the premises.
7. Catch & Release is required.
